
**Infertility is:**

Unable to conceive after 6 months of trying **>35** years old

Unable to conceive after 12 months of trying **<35** years old

**Did you know?**

Women are born with all of the eggs they will ever have.



**Approximately**

One-third of infertility is attributed to the **female partner**, **one-third attributed to the male partner** and **one-third** is caused by a combination of problems in **both partners or, is unexplained.**
