

































Acetaminophen (Tylenol®) Dosing Chart

Dose: Give every 4-6 hours as needed, no more than 5 times in 24 hours. Do not use in children under 3 months of age -- unless advised by your clinician.

Do not use under age 6 months unless advised by your clinician.

























^bFor ½ tablet measurements: use solid tablets only – do NOT break open gel caps

Important Notes

1. Ask your health care provider or pharmacist which formulation is best for your child.
2. Give dose based on your child's weight. Do not give more medication than recommended.
3. Always use the included measuring device OR an oral syringe given by the pharmacy. Kitchen spoons are *not* accurate measuring devices.
