### Clinical Presentation or Service Need

### Where to Refer

#### Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)

- Diagnosed within last 2 years
- Suspected or diagnosed more than 2 years ago

#### Behavioral Health Treatment (BHT) or Applied Behavioral Analysis (ABA)

- Child already receiving ABA
- Child who may benefit from ABA
- Displays pattern of developmentally inappropriate behaviors
- Child exhibiting developmental deficits that may be corrected or ameliorated

#### Mental health and substance use treatment

- Mental health symptoms or substance use impacting functioning
- Displays pattern of developmentally inappropriate behaviors that may be related to mental health issue.

#### Developmental delay / GGRC Early Start Program

- Child under 36 months who has a delay in adaptive, cognitive, communication, social, emotional, or physical and motor development
- Child under 36 months with established risk conditions or high-risk biomedical factors that could lead to a delay

#### Developmental disability / GGRC Lanterman Act Program

- Patients with intellectual disability, autism, epilepsy, cerebral palsy, or disabling conditions associated with an intellectual disability
- Patients that require treatment similar to individuals with an intellectual disability

#### Special Education / Early Start Program for Infants and Toddlers

- Child under 36 months with orthopedic, hearing and/or visual disabilities and who are not eligible for GGRC Lanterman Act Program

#### Individualized Education Program (IEP)

- Student with long term needs that affect their ability to learn or function at school

#### Neuromuscular rehabilitation/long term PT/OT support

- Child under 21 years with neuromuscular issues, showing signs of spasticity, illness/injury that requires extensive rehabilitation, or developmental issues requiring long term PT/OT support
