The HIMS department announces new dictation & transcription system

Currently LPCH uses Dictaphone for dictation and Digital Records Corporation (DRC) for transcription. **Starting August 12**, DRC will provide <u>both</u> dictation and transcription services to LPCH. The resulting system will be more robust, dependable and less expensive to operate.

What remains the same:

- 1. The in-house extension will remain the same (x7-8278) and the menu prompts will be nearly the same as before. See Table 1 for the new dictate control menu prompts.
- 2. The new system will have no impact on the Radiology Department. Radiology reports will continue to be dictated into Dictaphone.

What changes:

- 1. For providers who call into the dictation-transcription from outside of the hospital, there is a new toll free number. The new number is **877-577-9980**. The old toll free number will no longer work after **August 12**.
- 2. The voice prompt will ask you to key-in a patient's FIN number when dictating a report. You may still key-in the medical record number (MRN) if the FIN number is unavailable. The FIN number will help the hospital match the report with the proper LINKS encounter.
- 3. In agreement with the LINKS team, the work types have been simplified to a new hierarchy approved by physician committees. The new hierarchy will enable a clearer view of physician's reports. See Table 2 for the new work type hierarchy
- 4. For patient discharges or transfers external to LPCH please use the discharge summary work type (07)
- 5. For off-service and internal transfers please use interim summary work type (08)
