<b>FPPE</b>	FPPE CRITERIA LISTED BELOW. FPPE WILL BE ASSIGNED BY THE SERVICE CHIEF DURING THE APPROVAL PROCESS
<b>Definitions</b>	"General Supervision" means the definition specified at 42 CFR 410.32(b)(3)(i), that is, the procedure or service is furnished under the physician's overall direction and control, but the physician's presence is not required during the performance of the procedure. "Personal Supervision" means the definition specified at 42 CFR 410.32(b)(3)(iii), that is, the physician must be in attendance in the room during the performance of the service or procedure. "Direct Supervision" means that the physician or nonphysician practitioner must be present on the same campus where the services are being furnished. For services furnished in an off-campus provider based department as defined in 42 CFR 413.65, he or she must be present within the off-campus provider based department. The physician or nonphysician practitioner must be immediately available to furnish assistance and direction throughout the performance of the procedure. The physician or nonphysician practitioner does not have to be present in the room

when the procedure is performed.

	<b>Management of Disorders - General Supervision</b>		
	Obtain Full History - Physical, Diagnostic, and Comprehensive evaluation as appropriate to the disease process. This may include but is not limited to ordering of radiographic, sonographic and/or laboratory studies.		
	Diagnosis - Assessment of the status of the disease process		
	Treatment (may include one or more of the following): Performance of the standardized treatment procedures Ordering of diet, exercise, rehab services and/or durable medical equipment Referral for surgery and/or specialty services as necessary.		
	Education and Counseling - Assesses patient/family for readiness to learn. Provides written and/or verbal instructions at level and in language appropriate for patient/family understanding. Reviews the following topics: 1) Pathophysiology of diagnosis 2) Management plan 3) Medication, device, or equipment instruction 4) Medication side effects 5) Signs and symptoms to be monitored at home 6) Parameters for when patient/family should seek medical assistance.		
	Consultation required with the supervising physician for Acute decompensation or deterioration of patient status, including respiratory distress, change in level of consciousness, or evidence of cardiovascular compromise. Failure of symptoms to improve within a reasonable time frame. Review of specific management guidelines and possible complications related to treatment of disease process less familiar to the advanced practice provider. At the request of the patient, advanced practice provider or supervising physician.		
	Follow-up - Telephone contact or provider visit as indicated.		
	<b>Disease Management - General Supervision</b> (All other applicable standardized procedures in this document are followed during patient care management. All general protocols are followed. )		
	Common acute conditions or chronic stable conditions - A treatment plan is developed based on the standard of care and available resources.		
	Uncommon or unstable conditions - Management of the patient is either in conjunction with a physician or by complete referral to a physician or secondary care treatment facility.		
	Acute life-threatening conditions - Initial evaluation and stabilization of the patient may be performed with concomitant notification of and collaboration by a physician.		

	INTRAPARTUM/LABOR AND DELIVERY - Core Privileges of the CNM only: Triage, admit, work up, diagnose and manage term pregnant patients. Obtain consultation for care of the pregnant patient when less than 37+0 weeks gestational age. Amniotomy. Fetal surveillance to include external monitoring, placement of fetal scalp electrode and intrauterine pressure catheter for internal monitoring and amnioinfusion. Labor induction or augmentation for management of active labor. Administer local anesthesia, or order the start of inhalation or regional anesthesia. Vaginal delivery of single vertex fetus with repair of vaginal, 1st and 2nd degree perineal, vulvar, and labial lacerations. Episiotomy and repair. Spontaneous or manual removal of placenta. Management of shoulder dystocia. Obtain consultation when appropriate.		
	ANTEPARTUM & POSTPARTUM - Core Privileges Assess, diagnose, manage and discharge the postpartum mother of spontaneous vaginal delivery and cesarean section. Discharge and follow up care as appropriate for patient condition.
